Example(s) for modelling FRBR - FRAD

FRBR: Functional Requirements for Bibliographic Records

- was developed by IFLA (1992-1997), now being complemented for "authority data" and "subject cataloguing"
- defines stages / abstraction levels of intellectual products: Work, Expression, Manifestation, Item
- lacks an explicit notion of processes (how things are created/transformed/destroyed, how they evolve over time)
- is flawed by partially ambiguous definitions

CIDOC CRM (Conceptual reference Model)

- developed since 1996 by CIDOC / ISO TC46;
 now an ISO standard (ISO 21127)
- centres descriptions not around the things themselves, but around the events that connect people, material and immaterial things in spacetime
- models typologies both as classification means and as objects of the cultural-historical discourse
- makes it clear that appellations are entities distinct from the things they refer to
- lacks a model of intellectual work



How those basic ontological distinctions are reflected in $FRBR_{ER}$ and $FRBR_{OO}$ (simplified representation)










Relationships Gr1-Gr2: work




Relationships Gr1-Gr2: expression



FRAD Functional Requirements for Authority Data

Conceptual model from IFLA (1999 to 2007)

- ✓ Defines and analyzes :
- Informational objects : (cf. FRBR)
 - Products of intellectual or artistic activity: works, expressions, manifestations and items
 - Agents of this activity : persons, corporate bodies, families
 - Subjects of those products : concepts, events, places, objects
- ✓ Explains relationships between those entities
